Your New 2023 Medical ID Has New Information

This card will be your new medical ID for 2023. It is important to give your medical providers and pharmacy this new card starting in 2023. The 2023 Medical ID will be mailed in mid-December. The mailing address is based on your address listed in Workday. For the remainder of 2022, please use your current medical ID.

Prefix and Member ID Changes

Your Medical ID prefix is a 3-letter code before your Medical ID number and will be updated based on benefit plan type and location. The three prefixes are **TEF**, **EPO**, & **OFY** depending on the medical plan you are enrolled in.

Your Prefix will be...

TEF

If your plan offers the HPN network under the Value Copay Plan, your membership ID prefix will begin with TEF

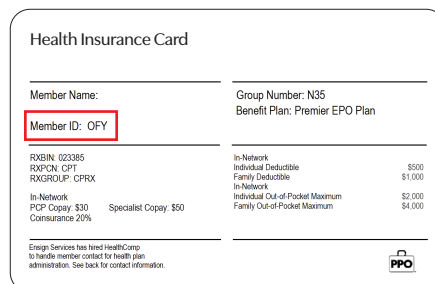
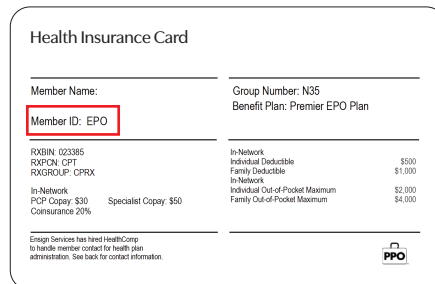
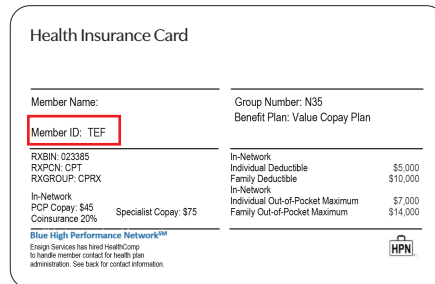
EPO

Utah Members in the Premier EPO Plan, Choice HSA PPO Plan, or the Value Copay Plan (where the HPN is not available) will have the prefix EPO on their medical ID cards

OFY

Members in all other states enrolled in Premier EPO or the Choice HSA PPO Plan, will have the prefix OFY

If HPN is not available in your area for the Value Copay plan, you will also have the prefix OFY
