Free 3-Year Term Life Insurance Policies for Frontline Healthcare Workers

In response to COVID-19, MassMutual has committed to pay the premiums for \$3 billion of insurance coverage for the HealthBridge program, which will offer free 3-year term life insurance policies to frontline healthcare workers. Most SNF and AL employees will qualify.

To be eligible for MassMutual's HealthBridge program:

- You must be between the ages of 18 and 60.
- You must be a U.S. citizen and resident or have permanent residency status.
- You are recently actively employed or volunteering at least 10 hours per month at a health care or emergency medical



services provider that is testing, treating, or evaluating patients for COVID-19.

- You work in a role where you have had or will have direct in-person contact with
 patients diagnosed with or being treated/evaluated for symptoms related to
 Coronavirus.
- You live or work in the United States where HealthBridge is available (not available in Puerto Rico or the U.S. Virgin Islands).
- You earn no more than \$250,000 per year.

Employees of AHCA/NCAL member facilities who are interested in the free life insurance program are encouraged to apply quickly before the \$3 billion cap is reached. Please note that the program is not intended to replace life insurance policies employees have already purchased.
